## Shipping Checklist

### 5.1 Export Packaging

Using high-quality packaging materials is the best way to prevent transportation damages. Manufacturers often use cheap, and substandard, export packaging, which often results in severe cargo damages during transportation. Hence, you must provide clear export packaging specifications.

**Important:** Include export packaging material specifications in Template 4A: Production Manual

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ 5 layer export quality cartons</li><li>✓ Plastic wrapping</li><li>✓ Wooden pallet</li><li>✓ Reinforced sides</li><li>✗ Plastic straps</li></ul>

1. Pallets may not be required for low-weight cargo. Always ask your freight forwarder to recommend whether pallets are necessary.

2. Plastic wrapping can protect against liquids and mould

3. Don't overpack/overload each individual carton
